All bills have been paid. \$50 check written to help with Hunter Safety lunch. Dublin store has done well with ticket sales. Another \$900 last weekend. - **4. Well Project** The well has been put in. The depth of 55' hit good water. Need a different breaker in the shed. Peterson's will be coming back to install the hydrant. Pictures were taken for the follow-up on the grant and forwarded to Wayne. Once completed a check will be issued for the work.
- 5. Hunter's Safety Harold reported that the class went very well. With all of the participants in the class and with parents coming, there were approximately 75 people there on site. A donation bucket was put out and Keith bought more supplies. These are temporarily put in the coolers in the shed.
- **6. Trap** End of the year monies were turned in. No more events scheduled for this year. A discussion about having another class on the machine before the snow falls. The new trap storage shed is all done. Greg stated that everything for trap will be moved over to the trap shed by November 1st. Greg Jr will be putting a lock on the shed.

Bud has been going around to look for donations for door prizes. Request for all members to look for donations for door prizes. Dale also brought gifts since he will be gone during the dinner.
