Board Meeting/Member Meeting

### 1. Call to Order – 6:32 pm

2. Minutes were reviewed for the May 2024 regular meeting. A motion to approve the minutes by Dave W was made, Seconded by Ron D. Unanimous approval was given.

### 3. Treasurer's Report

Kelly presented the financial report. All bills have been paid. The balance in the checking account is \$20,176.42. Motion to accept financial report by Dave, seconded by Ron. Unanimous approval.

### Old Business

1. Raffle Tickets - Discussion about the upcoming weekend and needing volunteers. Scheduling of ticket sales has been turned over to Kathy Weronko. A different email will be sending out notices. .
2. Promotional items – Dennis will look into pricing of hats, t-shirts and license plates by our July meeting.
3. Golf Outing – Bud reported that everything is moving along well. The teams are filling up fast. If there is anyone interested in participating, please contact Chris at the Pere Marquette Golf Course to sign-up. Donations/prizes are still needed. We are doing well, but we could use more Any member that can get contributions let Bud know. For the dinner after, the VFW will be handling all of the food. Our club will need to help with grilling the meat. Also, we will need a few volunteers for the golfing event. Looks to be about 8 people. We have 5 now that will be volunteering at the golf course.
4. Hunting lease – Pat Groulx was the winner of the Hunting Lease. Discussion on food plots. It is suggested Pat will create the plots and the Club will provide the seed. Motion by Dave, seconded by Harold to approve \$100 towards seed. Unanimous approval.
5. Hardscaping – The gravel laid before the 3-Gun Shoot looks wonderful. There is still more to do. Picnic tables to be moved to access under the pavilion.
6. Clubhouse - Discussion on the projected Clubhouse. Currently the fund for the Clubhouse, it is projected to take approximately 7 years to build it up where we want it. This would be for use for the members and for the public and have to be of commercial standards. A discussion was brought up about an alternative building for members only and of a smaller size. A smaller building on a slab, that at a later date could be moved if we wanted and then to build a larger clubhouse. More information is needed of what we can do. Pat Groulx will gather more information. Currently we have the money for a smaller building. Once we have all the information we need, a survey will be sent to all members for more feedback and thoughts.

New Business

A bid was presented for materials needed to complete this. Also a toolbox is needed in the storage shed to organize the tools we are building. Kelly has a toolbox to donate. Motion to approve up to \$600 for the materials needed for the lean to, second by Ron. Unanimous approval.

Harold also mentioned that the Markette will be adding sponsor signs and thought it would be a good idea for the club to advertise. - Dennis Parsons asked about selling tickets again during the Bitely Homecoming. Last year the Club ended up paying a vendor fee. The Bitely Homecoming is the 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend in July, 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>. Unanimous approval to see if Dennis can do this. Kelly will create a certificate for Dennis to present.
