

LAKE COUNTY SPORTMAN'S CLUB October 15, 2024 Board Meeting/Member Meeting

1. Call to Order – 6:30 pm

- 2. Minutes were reviewed for the September 2024 regular meeting. A motion to approve the minutes by Kelly with no corrections was made, Seconded by Dave. Unanimous approval was given.
- 3. Treasurer's Report

Kelly presented the financial report. All bills have been paid. The balance in the checking account is \$34,380.15 Motion to accept financial report by Harold, seconded by Bud Kloosterman. Unanimous approval. Kelly brought up about the CDs term dates coming due starting in November, December, and January. It was agreed that we were going to roll them over again.

Old Business

- <u>Raffle Tickets for our original order was 5,000 tickets and they are sold. Kelly ordered an addition 1,000.</u> We need members <u>who have not returned their tickets to get them in.</u> Kathy Weronko can be contacted at 231.797.5746 if anyone can help fill in a few hours before the dinner. Also, we have only 3 weeks left to sell tickets at the stores. Please volunteer for one of the upcoming weekends. Call Kathy.
- 2. <u>Dinner update –</u> The contract and menu were reviewed. Kelly noted that sour cream was not on the list. Each of the other additional guns being raffled for dinner attendees only will use a 52-card deck as tickets. When one gun's cards are sold, a winner will be drawn, and the next gun will be raffled. (Currently 1 rifle, 1 shotgun and a pistol will be raffled.) John will call Jeremy to verify his presence at the dinner and the guns for the additional raffles. Greg Nichols Jr. oversees the barbequing for dinner. Harold will order 225 steaks and the minimum amount of chicken, (approx. 40 lbs.).

- 3. <u>Promotional items</u> Dennis brought in the hats for purchase. (\$20 ea.). Our website will allow members to order for themselves, our club hats and t-shirts from our supplier. Different colors and styles will be available. The logo is already established with the company and when the member orders they can pick their choices and have them mailed directly to them.
- 4. <u>Trap House –</u>Dave completed the door refurbishment to the trap house door with metal. To add two handles for easier opening. Continual damage to the wiring is an issue. An electrician will be contacted about put the wiring in conduit underground. Some caulking needs to be finished. John Beach will call to ask for our in-house electricians to put the conduit underground and wiring for the microphone.

New Business

- 1. <u>Pole building-</u> John stated the new building cost is \$31,500 for a 30'X48" building. Concrete is \$8,640. Additional concrete will need to be added for the 8" porch and slab in front of the front door. We need to plan on \$10k for a septic system.
- 2. Free Sight in days are October 26th and November 13th at our range. They are free and open to the public 10 am to 4 pm. John Beach will pick up the water and snacks for the events. We need volunteers to help man the range on those dates. Currently Harold, Bud & John will be there on October 26th, Harold, Dennis, John, and Pat will be there on November 13th we need at least 4 more additional members for each event.
- 3. Bud gave a list of already donated items. He and Harold are working on more. <u>We are asking members</u> that have access to give away items for the dinner as door prizes or raffle items to please contact Dennis Karczynski to donate those items at 734-578-2754.
- 4. Next meeting we will be looking for nominees to fill Board positions in the Club whose term is ending. Voting is in December. Watch for an email.
- 5. Budget approval comes in December. If anyone has an item to be placed on the budget for next year, please contact Kelly.

8. Round Table

- John noted that people are using rifles at the pistol range and damaging targets. Reminder that cameras are mounted.
- Harold talked with Pat about excavation of the new trap area and pole building area. Pat will do what he can before the weather turns bad.
- We are in need of new trifold brochures for the club. Edits were discussed and approved. Harold made a motion for new trifolds to be purchased and not exceed \$500. Dennis seconded the motion. Unanimous approval was given.
 - The contact phone number was discussed on the brochure because the president changes each year. Member Blair Evans stated that one service, Google Voice, allows you to have one phone number and be able to forward to whomever the existing president is. Blair & Kelly will investigate and set up.
- Kelly brought up the Club sending members to class for Safety and Range officers. Discussion. Harold will research classes. Also, Dinner flyers were handed out to all persons present to distribute and hangup around the area. Harold will post on the Facebook page.
