Approved Minutes

1. Call to Order – 6:34 pm

2. Minutes were reviewed for the May 2025 regular meeting. A motion to approve the minutes by Bud, Seconded by Greg Nichols Jr. Unanimous approval was given.

3. Treasurer's Report

-2 bills in for Lawn Mowing and purchase of membership cards for a cost of \$330 for a New balance \$27,208
- Two CD's are coming due \$26,000 on June 25th and \$5,200 on July 1st Kelly asked if we should roll them over and after discussion everyone agreed to roll them over.

- Kelly requested that Greg Nichols Jr. deposit the Trap money

- All others bills are paid.

Harold made the motion to accept the financial report, Greg Nichols Jr. seconded. Unanimous approval of financial report was given.

4. Old Business

1. Raffle tickets – We need more members to schedule selling at local stores. Harold proposed buying pizzas for the ACE hardware staff in Baldwin for all their cooperation through the years allowing us to sell tickets at their store. Everyone agreed Len Todd will handle notifying and buying the pizzas from us to ACE hardware.
2. Kelly purchased and demonstrated the new P.A. system. A motion by Harold to reimburse Kelly for the purchase of the PA system was made. Bud Kloosterman 2nd it. Motion was voted on and passed unanimously.
3. Property excavation – John Beach received two quotes. After their review it was decided to give H&H Excavation Company the job to excavate the property for the new club house & parking lot.
4. RSO Class: Everyone passed. (Dave Weronko, Dennis Karczynski, Kelly Zoellner, and John Beach)
5. Dennis discussed the SOP for the Range. He will provide the Board a copy and asked for it to be reviewed within the next week. Also, he requested a separate safety meeting regarding the SOP in the near future after the SOP is approved.
6. Golf Outing status by Bud. We're on track from last year. Dennis is providing quotes for T-shirts to sell at the outing. Bud asked to please get out the flyers and sign people up.
7. The 3-GUN shoot is this Saturday. Workers need to be there at 10 a.m. bring a dish to pass. John Beach will provide the safety talk to all present.

5. New Business

1. Harold suggested with GEO practicing at our range to have the portable toilets pumped more frequent.
2. It was asked for all members to pay attention to the **RED SIGN** if posted at the gate, to DO NOT ENTER the range it is closed. This will occur when GEO officers are qualifying. Other events may cause it for closing such as Hunter's Safety Classes.
3. John to meet with GEO to discuss what they were looking for. Bud and Dave will be present. Only handgun qualifications for now. GEO will supply the targets. Approximately 200 officers in the two weeks need to be certified. Only a short-term contract will be offered at this moment. Possibly even a daily contract. We may need to get another porta-john brought in.
4. The new building prints are being revised to show Mechanical room, kitchen, counters, closets, etc. It was suggested to have 42" doors and a garage door installed for loading equipment into the building. Greg Jr. stated we will need panic doors installed as well.
5. Greg Nichols Jr. will attempt to get the original Federal survey of our property to help settle any dispute of property boundaries.
6. John Beach & Dave Worenko will schedule a WORK BEE to fix the gate at James Rd., & post signs on the east boundary and trim some boundary trees.
7. The need or need for a property manager(s) was discussed. Dennis requested a job description and compensation for the position, John Beach will provide the information later.
8. Women's CPL class: On June 28th we will be offering a CPL class for women only. Sheila Burns is the NRA instructor for the class. If any woman is interested in the class, please contact Kelly. The cost is \$125 per person. All classroom essentials are included with lunch being provided. Participants will bring their pistol and 50 rounds of ammunition. Class will be smaller for more individual hands on. **Students should be reminded to provide their own ear and eye protection.**
