Approved Minutes

### 1. Call to Order – 6:31 pm

### 2. Minutes were reviewed for the July 2025 regular meeting. A motion to approve the minutes by Kelly, Seconded by Greg Sr. Unanimous approval was given.

### 3. Treasurer's Report

-Kelly presented the financial report provided with explanation.

-All bills are paid.

-Current totals for CDs' are \$75,483.07 & Checking account is \$28,829.06

-Previously with the new set up with GEO the first invoice was not going to be received until September. It has been corrected, and we have received all. There was a new date for last Friday that needs to be invoiced.

-Trap money has been received.

-The dues have been checked and there is only one person not up to date. Board members will let him know. It will be time to send out notifications about gate combo change.

-Kelly presented a notice for a contribution for Five Cap Golf Outing. Greg Jr made a motion to approve \$200 donation, seconded by Bud. Discussion – depending on whether Lake County is included in the proceeds. Also, there is option for a tee sponsor of \$100. It was finalized to approve up to \$200. Kelly to call to see how it is split in the counties. Unanimous approval.

Greg Jr made the motion to accept the financial report, Greg Sr seconded. Roll Call: John, Aye; Dave, Aye; Ron, Aye; Bud, Aye; Greg Jr, Aye; Kelly, Aye; Greg Sr, Aye. Three absent. Approval of financial report.

### 4. Old Business

1. Status of Raffle Tickets – Dave said that when sales are done, they are doing well. There is still a problem of getting people to sell. We need to get some more volunteers.
2. Review of Golf Outing – Bud said that with a couple minor hiccups everything went really well this year. He also stated that he will need to back off from his involvement with the golf outing. He also mentioned that there is a guitar signed by Ted Nugent that did not arrive in time and will be held until next year's golf outing. He asked Kelly about the check from VFW for the split. As of today, we have not received it. The amount is \$3125.00.
3. Property/Excavation status – The property has been cleared and was a good job. John will be following up to see about fill. Dave is going to follow-up with Shawn James about the building prints.
4. SOP for Range – The first meeting has been completed to correct half of the drafted copy. A second meeting needs to be scheduled.

5. Federal Survey of property – Greg Jr did not find a copy of the survey anywhere. Discussion. Greg Jr will follow-up with local company.
6. Troutarama – Ticket sales at the car show went well for first year.
7. Chamber of Commerce – Kelly did send in the application. There are still questions about updating pictures, contact information, etc. A call was made to the Chamber of Commerce and left a message to have someone call her back.
8. In Case of Emergency Signs – the signs are in the shed. John said that they need a wooden back. Dale G. will be looking to see what he can do to get them up. These signs are for the range address in case there needs to be a call to 911 and the caller needs the address.
9. Annual Dinner – Jim has the contract for AMVETS for the annual dinner. The contract states that there are 150 chairs and 30 tables. Dave has a way to get extra tables and chairs. Discussion.

**5. New Business**

1. DNR Contact for shooting events – this was added by Dennis who is absent. Discussion on what we thought it was about posting upcoming events. John mentioned MUCC and how to get on the web page to post our events. We are a member with MUCC.
2. Rex Graham – this was approved last month. Dennis to follow-up with Rex.
3. Fall 3 Gun Shoot – Discussion on what is needed and who is going to be there. Email to be sent to members. Discussion.
4. Work Bee – No date was set at this time. There is a question about GEO using the range in the winter. Plowing is going to be needed. If plowing, the west range won't be able to be used with the PVC piping in the ground. So, they need to use the East Range. John/Bud will check with GEO about what they need so we can improve/correct what is needed on the East Range.
5. New Fee Box for Trap – Inside of the trap shed is a new box for members/guests to deposit fees for trap.
6. Spraying for Weeds – Kelly is looking for a professional that can come and spray quite a bit of area for weeds. Members will try and come up with suggestions.
7. Change a Couple Signs – a couple of the signs over the rifle range and pistol range needs changing. Dale G will take care of that.
8. Check-In Sheets – a new sheet has been created to use at each range. Everyone who comes in will sign in the sheet. Discussion on adding more cameras to all the range areas.

**6. Round Table**

\* Greg Jr brought up about the piece of property with the signs (Baldwin Road and front gate) that need to be more often than the ranges. That is the entrance to the facility and should represent better. Discussion. Kelly will check with Robert.
