1. Call to Order – 6:29 pm

2. Minutes were reviewed for the September 2025 regular meeting. A motion to approve the minutes by Harold, Seconded by Bud, Unanimous approval was given.

3. Treasurer's Report

-Kelly presented the financial report provided with explanation.

-Kelly will send an invoice to GEO

-Kelly presented a donation request from the Sheriff's Dept. for gun safety pamphlets to the school kids for \$132.50. A motion to approve the donation was made by Harold, Seconded by Bud, Unanimous approval was given.

-Kelly discussed a proposal by Northwest realtor concerning advertising in their books and digital road sign. \$150 for 6 months. A motion to approve the minutes by Harold, Seconded by Bud, Unanimous approval was given.

Dennis made a motion to approve the financial report, Harold seconded the motion to accept the financial report. Unanimous approval was given.

4. Old Business

1. Status of Raffle Tickets –There is still a problem of getting people to sell. We need to get some more volunteers. Kelly Stated we have sold a total of \$11,600 tickets to date.
2. Dennis said the DRAFT SOP is complete for the Range & will be sent for final review by next week. He had received two comments for edit by members and they were reviewed by the board.
3. Bud, on GEO in the winter. GEO will plow the range for the winter from the gate to the second pistol range. For their access for qualification.
4. Dale picked up the barrels for the east pistol range.
5. Kelly asked for someone else to work on researching cameras for the range and Harold volunteered.

5. New Business

1. John brought up a hunting lease issue. We have a member walking in the lease area disturbing the hunting. Dave Weronko will talk to that member. And John will verify that it is the lessee's pop-up blinds set up on the property.
2. Kristy gave an update on the banquet arrangements. Tina is back as cook at AMVETS. Her cost for cooking is \$250. She will buy all the food except for the steaks and chicken. Another lady will be

dishwasher at minimum wage. Harold will order the meat. The bar will open at 4 p.m. Kelly reviewed the need for help: BBQ cook (Greg Nichols Jr.??), Need members to bring desserts. Need workers for the 50/50 drawing, taking money at the door (Pam & Other), Dennis will MC, help with the raffles, etc...

- a. Harold made a motion to approve the cost of the other workers besides bartender at a cap of \$400, Jim seconded the motion. All voted and approved the motion.
3. A Site in day is this Saturday – John Beach will be there as RSO.
4. A full Hunters Safety Class is scheduled for Sunday October 25th run by Keith Bartram. The range WILL BE CLOSED THAT DAY during the class!!! Range will open after the class is completed about 3 pm.
5. Nomination of officers was discussed. All nominations, 2 year positions, must be given to Dennis (Secretary) before the next meeting. Officer's positions up for election are president, secretary and trustees. Kelly nominated John Beach for another term as president.

6. Round Table

- John Beach presented a safety concern brought to him by ANOTHER member. While at the range a person was shooting high at the pistol range over the berm.
- Dave & John asked Kelly to order Cozies' and hats. We are almost out.
- Harold announced there is a river cleanup of the Pere Marquette this Saturday. Hundreds of volunteers will be present. He asked for the club to sponsor refreshments for the volunteers. Maximum of \$100. Dennis made a motion to accept the donation, Greg Sr. seconded the motion. All voted and approved the motion. Harold will take care of purchasing.
- Bud asked to help the VFW get a license for the Guitar Raffle. Discussion ensued. John Beach will check with the lottery commission on the rules regarding raffles and sponsorships. John will follow-up with Bud.
- Member Fred Woldering stated he found the trap machine electrical system damaged. The plastic electrical box was run over and broken. Post to block the box will need to be put in next spring. Dale will investigate and repair.
- It was mentioned about the sign-in sheets and their positioning. Dale will check on that.
