Approved Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order – 6:15 pm

Present: John Beach, Dave Weronko, Ronald Dionne, Bud Kloosterman, Harold Nichols, Kelly Zoellner, Greg Nichols Sr, James Young

2. Minutes were reviewed for the November 2025 regular meeting. A motion to approve the minutes by Harold, Seconded by Ron. Unanimous approval was given.

3. Treasurer's Report

- Kelly presented the financial report. Showing a checking account balance of \$49, 987.35.
- CDs will start coming due in January. A request to add to the CD in January of \$5357 to increase to \$10K to allow for a little higher interest. Harold made the motion to approve the extra money to increase the one CD to \$10K, with an additional \$10K for an additional CD, Bud 2nd. Unanimous approval.
- Review of the annual dinner. Showed a breakdown report of money's in and out. Ending with \$9400 cleared for the dinner. Note: the vendor/AMVET has not been paid for yet. Jim will follow up.
- Kelly presented an invoice for clay pigeons at \$2500. Discussion. The current fund only has \$1200 in the account. The purchase was not discussed with the board beforehand. Dave made a motion to approve paying \$1200 from the trap account on the invoice, second by Jim. Unanimous approval.

Harold made the motion to accept the financial report, Greg Sr 2nd. Unanimous approval.

4. Old Business

1. SOP procedures – Discussion. Jim made motion to accept the SOP Procedures, Dave 2nd, with unanimous approval.
2. Review GEO – Bud – the projects that we have submitted for funding from GEO has been submitted for annual budget approval. Waiting for a response. Also, Bud mentioned there was a discrepancy with the sheriff's department about barrels getting shot up. GEO purchased 20 barrels and gave 10 of them to the sheriff's department. Bud also stated that last he knew there were 80 people still to qualify at the range. Discussion on the invoicing to GEO. Kelly stated all up to date with payments.
3. Annual Voting – With only the current officers being nominated for their existing positions Harold made a motion to accept the nominations for this year's elections, Jim 2nd, unanimous approval. These officers voted in will have a two-year term. John Beach, President; Dennis Karczynski, secretary; trustees – James Young, Greg Nichols Sr, Bud Kloosterman.

5. New Business

1. Kelly - MUCC sent their brochures for youth camp for 2026. Harold mentioned that Rotary received the same. He is going to talk with Rotary and see about co-sponsoring a youth. Registration cannot be started until the end of January 2026.
2. Kelly – Finally the pictures from the annual dinner are uploaded on to the web page.

3. Bud – The Ted Nugent guitar box has been built and mounted at VFW. Tickets will start to be sold as of January 1st5. Available at VFW. \$5 each or 5 for \$20. Bud will get information to post on our Facebook page and web page.
4. Dave – brought up that we still have the side-by-side day rental from Best Bear. The Club has attempted a couple of times to use it for events and no one bid. Harold also had talked with the owner of Best Bear and it is still available. \$700 value. Suggested that we have a silent auction with current members only. Highest bidder will win the day pass for a side by side.

 - Kelly – will add it to the web page

The deadline for the bids is January 20th.
5. Dave – brought up about purchasing the new guns for 2026 raffle. He will contact Jeremy about the guns. John is going to get approval of the raffle winners and then give to Kelly to put on the web page.
6. Dave – has sent thank you cards to the businesses for allowing us to utilize their locations.
7. John – received a thank you note from the sheriff's department for contributing to the safety program.
8. Kelly – December is usually the time to set up dates for the following year's events. It will be added to the first item on January's agenda.
9. Harold – Previous years the Club has donated to the Village of Baldwin coffee fund for allowing us the use of the building. Discussion. Harold made a motion to approve \$250 to the Village of Baldwin's coffee fund, Bud 2nd, unanimous approval. Kelly to contact Teresa, Village Clerk.
