Approved Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order – 6:27 pm

2. **The Secretary's Minutes** were reviewed for the regular April 21st, 2026, meeting. A motion to approve the minutes by Kelly, Seconded by Dave W.. Unanimous approval was given.

3. **Treasurer's Report**

- All bills are paid. The New BBQ was bought, delivered and paid for, Assembly required.
- Liability Insurance went up for both companies. All paid.
- **Our current checking account balance is \$4,133.05, Savings \$22,510.44**
- **All current CD's total is \$92,639.91**
- For sales of raffle tickets, a \$100 start-up will be in the money box.
- Waiting for Greg Jr. trap deposit from Spring League.
 - Greg Jr. Made a motion to accept the current budget as stated. Bud Kloosterman seconded the motion to approve the current budget as read. All approved.

• **Old Business**

1. Harold has ordered the cameras and is waiting for delivery.
2. A work bee day scheduled is scheduled for Saturday June 6th **** Need a tractor & trailer**
 - a Put up signs around perimeter of club
 - b Replace 100-yard gong
 - c Assemble new BBQ grill
 - d Move car port
 - e Move berm (Pat Groulx)
 - f Take inventory of clays
 - g Spread last load of gravel for paths if delivered
3. Dave Werenko & John Beach will contact volunteers and excavator (Pat Groulx) for day to construct new enclosure for second pistol range on West Pistol range.
4. Bud – Presented 1st \$500 check of \$7500 approved donation from GEO for construction of new range enclosure.
5. Need safety officers for 3-gun shoot on June 20th & any organized event. Discussion on adding more safety officers and training.
6. Bud – Golf outing on track for Sunday August 2nd

5. New Business

1. With the gate locked to the range; the trap machine was found running, damaged and most of the clays shot up. No money in the collection box, no sign in sheets used. After much discussion it was decided to a.) temporarily shut down the electronic/automated trap machine, b.) change the locks on the trap shed c.) make the hand thrower available to members, d.) members bring and use their own clays until a permanent plan is in place for the automated trap equipment. ****Board members will meet one hour before the next meeting in June to discuss and decide the use of the trap area and equipment.**
2. Bud said raffle tickets for the VFW “TED NUGENT” guitar are ready & available.
3. Kelly notified the board that she had received a notice in the mail that our current lawn maintenance is no longer going to be available. Kelly contacted Collin Jett about this and asked to present to the board. Collin presented an offer, answered questions. Which includes the road sign area at Baldwin and McKinley Roads. Cost is \$1080 (discounted to pay up front for the year to include bi-weekly cutting at Baldwin Road and 3 to 4 times for the ranges as needed. Collin’s proposal kept in line with what we currently had been paying. Kelly made a motion to approve the contract. Dave seconded the motion. All voted and approved the motion.
4. Collin had proposed in 2025 a contract for spraying weeds on the range property. Discussion for 2026. The spray is safe to humans and animals, will last for one year. If it is found not working in an area, (For all gravel & road areas) Collin will re-spray at no additional cost. Cost of the proposal is \$745. The same dollar amount would be accepted for 2026. Bud made a motion to accept and pay for the contract; Greg Jr. seconded the motion. All voted in favor of accepting and paying the contract.
5. Kelly read a proposal from Maple Woods to cut wood on our property. A vote was taken by the board and turned down the proposal.
6. Kelly read a letter from a Reed City H.S. Band member requesting financial assistance/donation for a summer music camp at Blue Lakes. The letter and background were read. Bud made a motion to donate \$150 to the student, Dave seconded the motion. All voted in favor to approve the motion.
7. Fred Woldring Sr presented a request for a donation to the Disabled American Veterans for enabling them to hunt. We have donated in years past. Dennis made a motion to donate \$100; Kelly seconded the motion. All voted in favor to pass the motion.
8. Member, Kevin Walker, discussed putting in add in the Irons Flea Roast trifold for the club. Cost of \$175. Kelly made a motion to buy the ad for \$175, and Greg Jr. seconded the motion. All voted in favor of purchasing the ad.
9. Member, Andrew Harter, brought up a safety concern he experienced at the range last week. While at the pistol range with his family, another member parked their vehicle in front of the firing line on the rifle range and began to shoot at target down range. It was agreed by all board members that this was not safe. The member who created the unsafe situation was present. The member was instructed in safe operating procedures and not to do this again. The member agreed not to park in an unsafe area.

Round Table – None presented.

Adjourn Meeting – Motion to adjourn by Ronnie, Greg Sr. 2nd the motion, unanimous approval. Meeting adjourned at 7:51 p.m. **The Next meeting is Tuesday, June 16th, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. at the Range.
